Test of endurance

Three-time Olympic medalist Edwin Moses and three-time Tour de France winner Greg LeMond were at the Worcester Public Library yesterday as the city unveiled a statue to 1899 world cycling champion Marshall W. "Major" Taylor, who was known as the "Worcester Whirlwind." The statue, by Antonio Tobias Mendez, is the Central Mass. city's first monument to an African-American, according to Worcester officials.
